Tena Perišin, Ph.D. teaches television journalism at the Journalism Program at the Faculty of Political Sciences in Zagreb and is actively involved in television media research. Ms. Perišin also established the television studio at the Faculty of Political Science. She completed her Doctoral degree with a thesis on Selection and Values in Television News.

Earlier she became a Master of Science at the Faculty of Philosophy in Zagreb with a thesis on film theory. She also attended the Masters studies program at Harvard University (USA) in 1984/1985, and was recipient of the Hubert Humphrey Scholarship Program at the S.I. Newhouse School of Public Communications at Syracuse University (USA) in 1994/1995.

At the same time, she is an active television journalist. She is employed at the public television (HRT, Croatian Radiotelevision) as the Assistant News Director and also in charge of the news digitalization project at Croatian Television in Zagreb (HRT). She is also a producer of the weekly magazine on European issues, "Euromagazin," for which she won the Erasmus EuroMedia Seal (2006) and the Erasmus EuroMedia Medal (2007, 2008) from the European Society of Education and Communication.

Tena Perišin is a member of the EBU News Committee and a member of the EBU File Transfer group. She is also active member of the EBU News Assembly.
